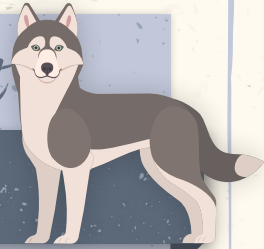

DOG CHECKLIST

It is of the upmost importance to register your pet with a vet and take them for regular health assessments. Always consider pet insurance as vet bills can add up and are often unexpected. A microchip is a legal requirement in all dogs from 8 weeks of age. Discuss the benefits of neutering your dog, especially if you have no intention of breeding from them.
