



RABBIT CHECKLIST

It is of the upmost importance to register your pet with a vet and take them for regular health assessments. Always consider pet insurance as vet bills can add up and are usually unexpected. We highly recommend microchipping rabbits. Discuss the benefits of neutering your rabbit, especially if you have no intention of breeding from them.

There are many different breeds of rabbit available as pets. Most have similar needs but their enclosure requirements might be different depending on their size. Some rabbits will also need grooming.
